Each state adopts a "statute of limitations" that sets the maximum period of time an injured individual can wait before filing a lawsuit. The statute of limitations rule is different in every state and depends on the type of case or claim.

We will be making a detailed analysis of the proper statute of limitations based on your injury after a more detailed discussion with you and, in some cases, after gathering your medical records.

In some situations, we are also able to argue that a "discovery rule" should apply which works to suspend the start of the statute of limitations. The discovery rule takes into account the timeframe in which the injured party discovered or reasonably should have discovered the cause of their injury.
